

Written Stage Briefing

CM 26-05 Downrange? Obviously is a 12 round, 60 point Comstock Classifier course. There are 6 USPSA targets. The best 2 hits per target will score. The start signal is audible.

The **Handgun Start Position** is standing completely outside of the shooting area facing downrange with toes touching the start marks. Handgun is loaded and holstered with wrists below belt.

The **PCC Start Position** is standing completely outside of the shooting area facing downrange with toes touching the start marks. Carbine is loaded with stock touching belt.

The **Make Ready** position is at the start position.

On the start signal, engage the targets from the shooting area.

Setup Notes:

All targets are 5 ft to the perforations at the shoulders.

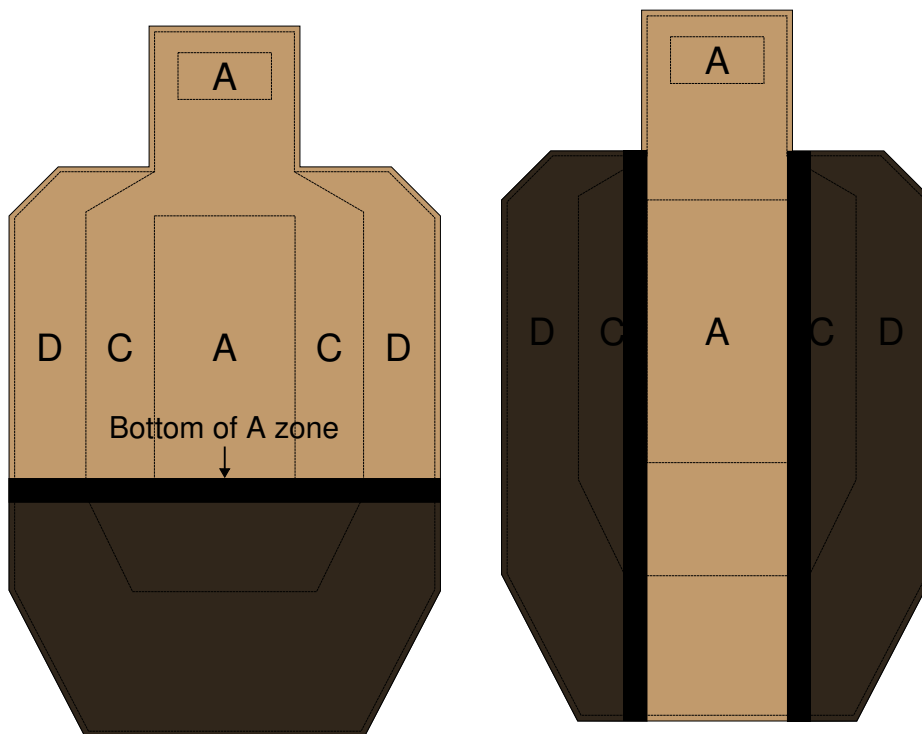
Center-to-Center of the Start Marks is 18 inches. Start Marks are centered on the left most fault line.

The **blue line** in the **Build Diagram** indicate the direction to point the angled target.

Stage Footprint:

- Width: 27 ft
- Depth: 50 ft
- Suggested Min Bay Size: 30 ft by 55 ft





T1 is a hardcover partial aligned with the bottom of the lower A-zone.

T4 is a classic Tuxedo with hardcover aligned with the A/C perforations.

T2 and T4 hard cover alignments.
